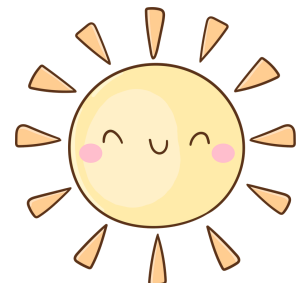

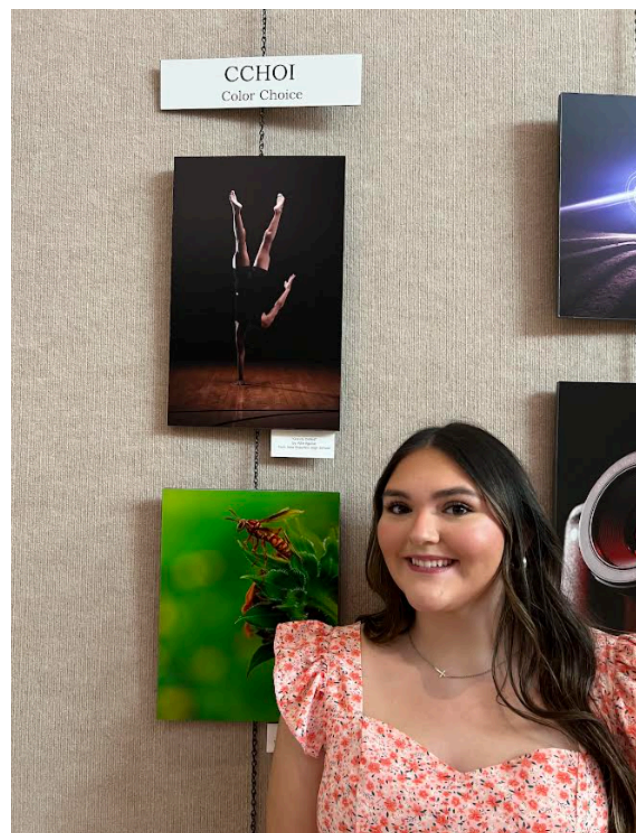


Karnes and Dewitt Counties

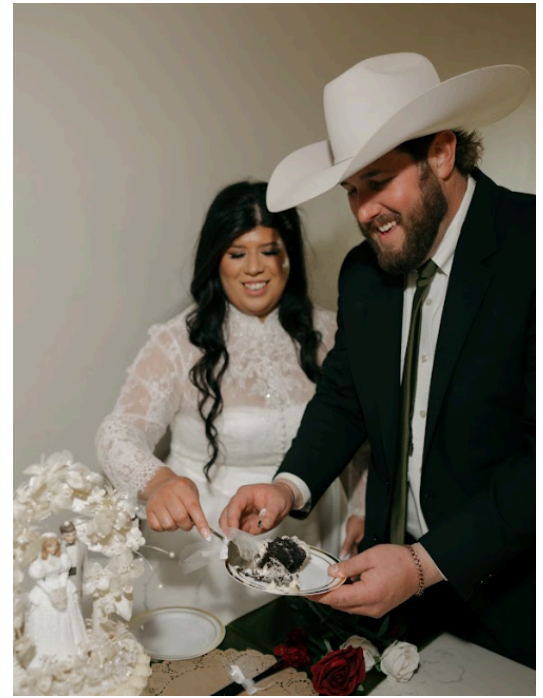
Guadalupe County

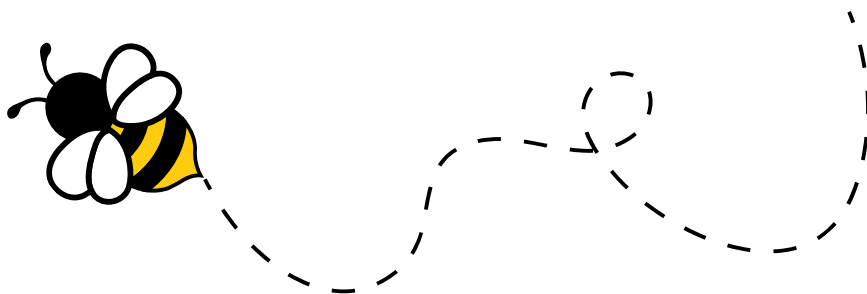

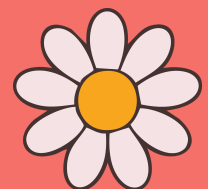
